The protection of your personal data has a high priority for EnOcean GmbH (hereinafter referred to as EnOcean). It is important for us to inform you of what personal data is collected, how it is used, and what rights and objection possibilities you have.

2. Personal data that are processed

With the purchase of an EnOcean IoT Connector and the associated licensing, EnOcean processes the following personal data:

- Name
- Company name
- E-mail address
- IP address
- Device ID and device name

3. Purpose and legal basis of data processing

Personal data is processed on the basis of art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR for the purpose of licensing and fulfillment of obligations under the contract.

4. Disclosure of data to third parties

In some cases, we use external service providers, so-called processors (e.g., for licensing, IT), who may also process or view personal data as part of their service. We have concluded special contracts (so-called "order processing contracts") with these processors. EnOcean remains responsible for the protection of your data.

5. Duration of data storage

our personal data will be stored for the purpose of establishing, implementing and terminating the contract and for the purpose of complying with statutory archiving and retention obligations for as long as is necessary to fulfill these purposes, usually 10 years.

6. Rights of the data subject

You have the right,

- a) to request **information** concerning the categories of the processed data, reasons for the processing, any recipients of the data, the planned duration of storage (Article 15 GDPR);
- b) to request **correction or supplementation** of incorrect or incomplete data (Article 16 GDPR);
- c) to **revoke** at any time a granted **consent**, with future effect (Article 7 para. 3 GDPR);

- d) in certain cases, within the scope of Article 17 GDPR, to request the **deletion of data** – particularly if the data is no longer required for the intended purpose or is processed unlawfully, or if you have withdrawn your consent in accordance with c) above or have declared an objection in accordance with h) below;
- e) under certain conditions, to demand the **restriction of data** if deletion is not possible or the obligation to delete is disputed (Article 18 GDPR);
- f) of **data portability**, i.e., you can obtain the data you have provided to us in common machine-readable format, such as CSV, and if necessary, transmit it to others (Article 20 GDPR);
- g) to contact the competent **supervisory authority** and **lodge a complaint** (Article 77 GDPR). The responsible supervisory authority for data protection issues is the Bavarian State Office for Data Protection, which you can reach via the following contact data:
